How will the day work?

For the first hour the students will work with their mentors and divide into groups based around the Moonshots that Big Blue Sky has created OR they have the choice to create a new Moonshot of their own.

They will then be free to watch all the speakers on the Big Blue Sky Program, hear the panel sessions and meet with their mentor groups during the breaks and lunch to discuss their thoughts.

At 4pm they will have 2 hours dedicated to working in groups and with their mentors on the presentation of their 'Moonshot'...the 'big, hairy, audacious goals and dreams' for the future of THEIR City.

These will then be presented to the Big Blue Sky audience with each group having ten minutes.

How will you be involved?

1. FRAMEWORK FOR YOUR DAY

The Big Blue Sky team will provide a framework built around the themes, purpose and structure of the broader event. We will work and build your presentations using the purpose of the event and the Moonshot themes. The framework will be along the lines of:

Align with the Big Blue Sky purpose: Bringing together diverse and inspirational thinkers and speakers to inspire action and build connections that positively affect the future of the GC and beyond.

Use the content presented by the Big Blue Sky speakers to shape and inspire your thinking.

Present with the 3 Moonshots as themes - IT, Innovation and Intelligence, Sustainable Gold Coast, Provisioning the Impossible OR create a Moonshot of your own

Work in diverse and collaborative teams in the Moonshot area of your individual choice - don't have to stick to your school group

Present to the current leaders and thinkers present, your 'big, hairy, audacious goals and dreams' for the future of the GC, what already exists that you can build on, how you can contribute, what you would need the leaders of today to lay down for you to make your ideas possible, the problems you may need to overcome etc.

2. WORKING PROCESS

As future leaders of the Gold Coast and beyond, we will hand the decision making process of how you work together and the content you present over to YOU in synergy with the framework presented above

We will work with you for the final 2 hours before your presentation to complete your projects. You will meet with the mentors throughout the day to begin to collate and collect their ideas and shape their presentations.

3. MENTORING

The people working with the students will act as mentors throughout the day, using the final 2 hours to coach / mentor completion of their presentations.

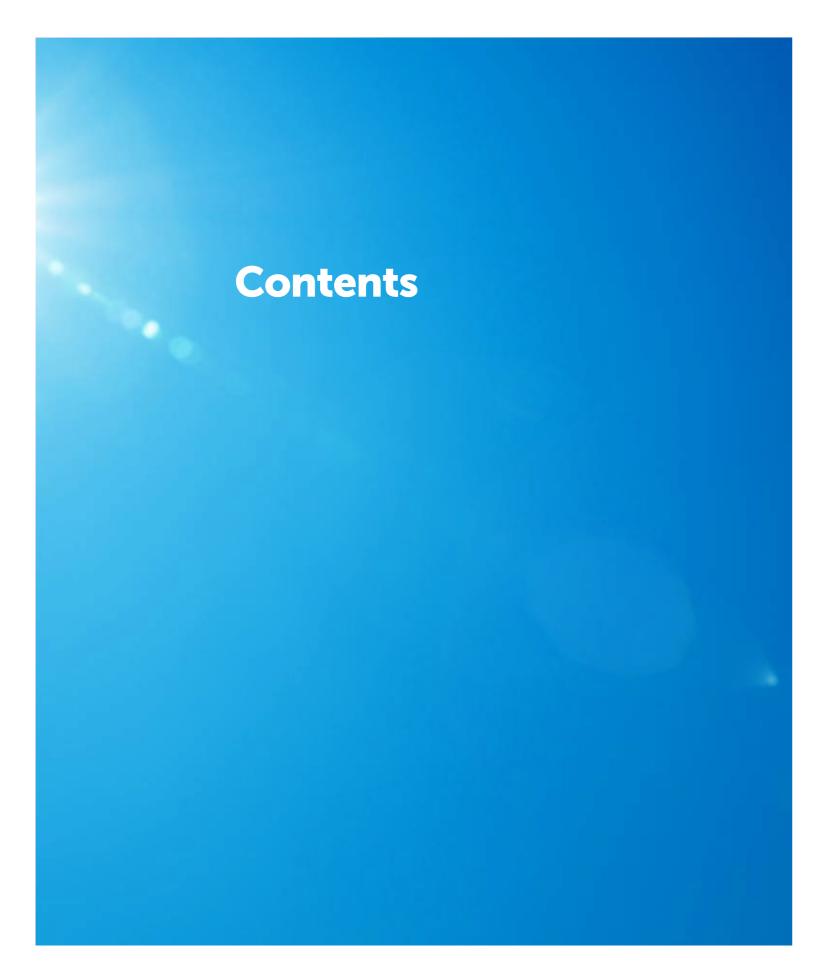

Project 1

BIG BLUE SKY WILL CONTINUE AS A PROJECT STEWARD

We are currently setting up the structure, which will include sourcing funding to cover salaries for a full time Big Blue Sky team that will exist to:

Project 2

EXTREME DRONE CIRCUIT RACE - GOLD COAST

In partnership with Downtown Las Vegas, and the City, Big Blue Sky team will co-ordinate the first XDC race in Australia, on the Gold Coast in February 2016. This event will bring together 3D printing, tech, digital, gaming, sports, tourism, music and food. It will also invite leaders in drone technology for collaborative discussions on the future of drones in our environment; the good, the bad and the ugly.

- It will get kids out of their rooms.
- It will showcase the city to a global audience.
- It will invigorate the youth maker movement.
- It will form a relationship with other XDC cities, such as Bournemouth in the UK and Downtown Las Vegas.

We anticipate this will be an annual event that will reinforce the GC as the city for both fun and technology.

The processional effects of this with the University engagement will be to have the city become a place for advanced use of remote vehicles and robotics in Australia.

Project 3

SUNRISE YOGA

As result of the success of the dawn opening of Big Blue Sky, we are working with Surfers Paradise Alliance to have the Sunrise Yoga become a monthly public/community event. We will always include the welcome to dawn opening with a local Aboriginal playing the dig, a local artist followed by free yoga on the beach.

It will become an opportunity for students, business people, locals and tourists to come together and offer a chance for conversation on the sand following the yoga. The event will be marketed to both locals and tourist alike. We will ensure that we create #GoldCoast branded photo opportunities so that these images will go around the world.

CONVERSATIONS & PROJECTS



Project 4

INTEGRAL ACCOUNTING AUDIT OF THE CITY

Dr David Martin, one of our most esteemed guests, has committed to undertake an all systems audit of the city, January 2016. This audit will provide a very advanced lens in which to view the city. This will enable thoughtful and specific attention to be given to 'acupuncture points' that while not always obvious, have the capacity to unlock enormous potential, often at a low financial cost.

It is anticipated that this audit will also include a learning aspect for those people who seek to understand the Integral Accounting technology to a higher degree. Big Blue Sky has been built entirely on the platform of Integral Accounting so as to become one of the first models in the world of Integral Accounting in action.

Project 5

PLACING COMMONS SPACES ON THE BLOCKCHAIN

This will ensure full transparency of all activities, and the inability for any party to violate the public agreement of the commons spaces. This project will require the collaboration between the tech sector, the public and citizens. If successful, this technology can be used for common's spaces worldwide.

Project 6

CREATE A DIGITAL PORTAL FOR BUSINESS/ENTREPRENEURIAL NEWS/EVENT SUCCESS STORIES

As Matt Desmier said, the beaches and tourism are doing fine. The city does not need another story about the beaches. We do need to let the world know about the intelligence we have here.
